THE 26TH ANNUAL CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN CONFERENCE

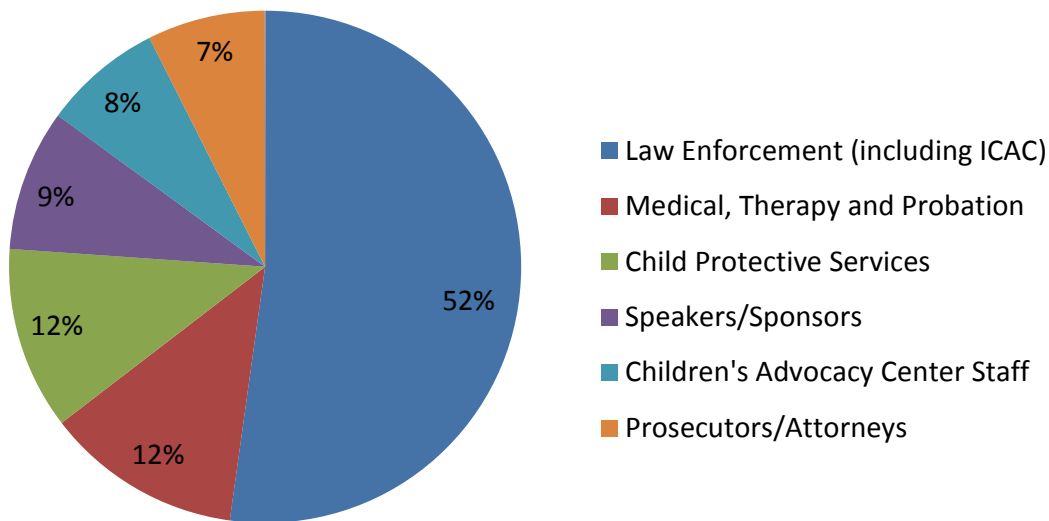

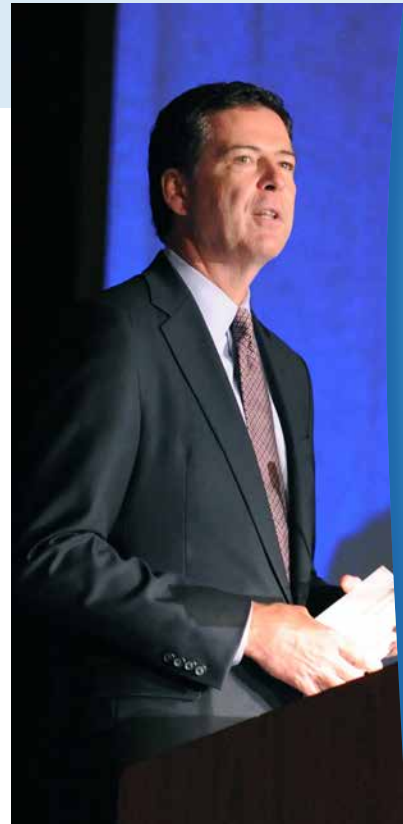

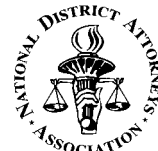
