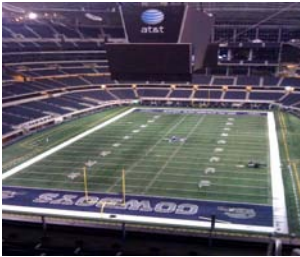


Cowboys Stadium - host to Super Bowl XLV!

Enjoy the top sights and attractions of Dallas' Downtown, Uptown and Highland Park on this exciting city tour! Visit Dealey Plaza in the West End Historic District, birthplace of Dallas and site of the tragic JFK assassination. Visit Dealey Plaza and see the world famous Sixth Floor Museum, which is dedicated to the life, death and legacy of President John F. Kennedy. Visit the Grassy Knoll where bystanders heard gunshots and learn little known details of that fateful day.



At the Old Red Courthouse hear about the colorful history of Dallas from the 1800's to present...stop by John Neely Bryan's Cabin and the Kennedy Memorial. Explore the spectacular Pioneer Plaza, a downtown public park, which commemorates a cattle drive of larger-than-life Texas Longhorns and hear stories about cowboys and cattle drives!

SOUTHFORK RANCH



No visit to Dallas is complete without a stop at the legendary Southfork Ranch! Tour the famed Ranch and Ewing Mansion and relive exciting moments from the series. You will be welcomed by Southfork's Visitor's Center; enjoy its expansive gift shop and museum!



See the gun that shot J.R., Lucy's wedding dress, video clips from the series, interviews with the stars, and other memorabilia that will make you feel at home with the most infamous Texans of them all, the Ewings.



From the Visitor's Center, relax on a guided tram tour of the ranch grounds in route to the Ewing Mansion. You'll hear a history of the ranch and see Texas Longhorns and American Quarter Horses. At the Ewing Mansion, enjoy a fully guided tour, including interesting tidbits about the years of filming and insight into the character of the Ewings.

As you depart the mansion, feel free to stroll through the grounds...stop and visit "Lincoln's and Longhorns," displaying Jock Ewing's original 1978 Lincoln Continental. 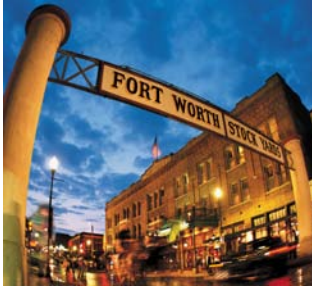

Fort Worth Highlights Sightseeing Tour



“Where The West Begins.” Indians. Cattle. Railroads. Oil. The History of Fort Worth reads like the history of the American West. In downtown’s dazzling Sundance Square, hear of the people and events that shaped Fort Worth’s rich history. Hear tall tales about the Chisholm Trail and the famous outlaws, Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid. Learn about Hell’s Half Acre where saloons, gambling parlors, shooting halls and dance halls once flourished and hear stories of the cities colorful past!

Visit the superb Sid Richardson Museum to enjoy western art by masters Russell and Remington....Fire Station #1 for exhibits featuring 150 years of Fort Worth’s colorful history....and the Bass Performance Hall, a cultural crown jewel. Stop by Hotel Texas where President Kennedy spent his last night and visit Wells Fargo Bank to see an authentic Stage Coach.

Then off to explore the legendary Fort Worth Stockyards National Historic District. Enjoy a guided walk of the Stockyards and learn about the historic attractions that speak to a bygone era when the town was a stop for the legendary cattle drives on the Chisholm Trail. Visit the Livestock Exchange, the “Wall Street of the West”. See Cowtown Coliseum site of the world’s first indoor rodeo. Visit the White Elephant Saloon – the interior was used in the filming of *Walker Texas Ranger*. Tour the Stockyards Hotel and experience an era when cattle and cotton were common currency and outlaws were folk heroes. Try on cowboy boots at one of the many western stores or pick up a memento or gift from Stockyards Station. Experience The Old West come to life before your eyes as a team of cowhands drives a herd of Texas Longhorns along Exchange Avenue. Every detail of this cattle drive...from the saddles to the chaps, from the hats to the boots — is authentic!
